Keeping you in the Loop - Those of you who were at the last meeting will remember that I mentioned the possibility of moving our "General Meetings" from the Anthony Hall to Green Park in Stable Bridge Road. Since that meeting the committee have visited the site and asked them to draw up a contract to allow our use over the coming years. We have now received their proposals and regretfully the committee are unable to agree with many of their requirements. In short, they may not be able to accommodate us on the same day every month and whilst the room rental is acceptable for 2014 we would be confronted with a 50% rise in 2015 and another 50% rise in 2016. There would also be charges for using their equipment and a charge of £1.65 p per person for a cup of tea or coffee. To agree to their proposals would require a significant increase in our subscriptions or a significant depletion of our financial reserves, neither of which the committee felt to be viable. I have asked Maggie E & Colin T to explore the possibility of negotiating more reasonable costs. In the event that is not possible, I regret we will not be able to make the move. I will keep you in the picture if we are able to negotiate better terms. Pat Mc (Chairman)
