Winter in Windsor - Thursday 6th of December

PLEASE NOTE - The itinerary for this trip has changed from that originally envisaged. The Saville Building doesn't accept coach trips for coffee any more and the Crown estates aren't releasing the price for entry into the Saville Gardens until October but the likely price is expected to be in the region of £10.

New Itinerary is as follows:

Meet the Blue badge guide at 10.30am in Windsor where there will be time to buy refreshments.

Our tour starts in St George's Chapel, continuing to the state apartments, then onto George IV's private rooms. By visiting these apartments in the morning people can take their time. We have free time in Windsor for lunch.

After lunch we board the coach for a look at the royal landscape taking in the views of the castle from the long walk. We finish with a visit to the Windsor Farm shop. We leave Windsor at approx 4.45pm
