Legal London - Discovering the Inns of Court. This trip has been organised for Thursday 18th of February. The coach company has suggested that we leave Aston Clinton at 8.15 as we have to meet our guide at Grays Inn, Holborn at 10.30. We see how the Inns of Court are laid out. Our guide will trace the history, traditions and peculiar practices of English law. We visit Staple Inn, Inn of Chancery and Lincolnshire Inn.

Lunch is at a public house near Grays Inn (this is a one course lunch plus coffee , all included, I have been advised that there will be three choices plus a vegetarian option)

After lunch we go by coach to the Old Bailey and take a gentle walking tour to the Inner and Middle Temple. There will be time in Fleet Street to buy coffee or tea before we leave at 4.45.
